

GUIDELINES/RULES/REGULATIONS/INFORMATION FOR ORGANIZERS OF: MULTI-DISTRICT, STATE OPEN, MASTERS, ALL INDIA RANKING, INTERNATIONAL RANKING & LEAGUE EVENTS

1. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION FOR MULTI-DISTRICT, STATE OPEN, MASTERS, ALL INDIA RANKING, INTERNATIONAL RANKING & LEAGUE EVENTS UNDER MBA:

- i. The tournament organizers will make an application to the concerned District Association. If found OK, the District secretary will forward the same to the Hon Secretary MBA who will check for availability of dates and give approval for the tournament subject to fulfilling of guidelines. From there it will be the responsibility of the District Secretary regarding the smooth conduction of the tournament as per MBA guidelines. In case if the District Association doesn't exist or is dis-affiliated, then the organizer may approach the Hon Secretary MBA with their application. Tournament applications must be received by MBA office minimum One month in advance.
- ii. No direct tournament application by any individual or Event Management companies shall be entertained unless it is sent through the respective District Association.
- iii. MBA reserves the right to sanction appropriate number of events as per availability of courts and infrastructure. Under no circumstances the scheduled last match will be beyond 9.00pm. The players can be restricted to play in not more than 3 events in cases where it becomes difficult for referee to schedule matches.

2. EVENTS TO BE ORGANISED, TOURNAMENT FEES & ENTRY FEES.

The Tournament organized in the following events and maximum entry fees that could be charged have been mentioned against each of the event. Entry fee will change in case the BAI makes changes in their rules & guidelines.

Please note that the Under 9 Yrs event is a non-selection event and it is as such NOT MANDATORY to conduct this event for the Organizers therefore its prize money is not mentioned in the Guidelines.



- i. It will be the responsibility of the organizers to collect the entry fees. Organizers shall pay Rs. 200/- per player per entry within 7 days after conclusion of the Tournament received to Maharashtra Badminton Association's account out of which 50 % shall be returned to District Association/organizer on completion of all required formalities like submission of draw copy, payments to the umpire and chief referee as per the norms, prize money as advertised etc.
- ii. 5% of the total prize money declared by the organizers shall be given by the organizers to the Maharashtra Badminton Association (for State or National level tournament) within 7 days after conclusion of the Tournament

3. GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- i. The Players registered with Railways, Petroleum, Air India, other such organizations and Combined Universities can participate in these events only on their birth right or who have domicile status in Maharashtra for a period of at least 6 months prior to the date of Tournament.
- ii. No District Association or organizers can use any other mode of accepting entries except MBA website.
- iii. The district association of the organizing district & MBA shall be kept in picture and their consent should be sought in all organizational matters.
- iv. During the official functions of the tournament the organizing Secretary shall follow the protocol in Consultation with Hon. Secretary MBA. It is advised that minimum 40 % of the seats on the dais shall be provided to the officials of the MBA.
- v. Organizers of the Tournament must provide the following minimum facilities at the Tournament Venue:
 - (a) Sound System to be provided at the Referees table during all the Tournament days.
 - (b) Separate dressing rooms for Gents and Ladies, along with clean toilets.
 - (c) Filtered and hygienic Drinking water.
 - (d) One person should exclusively be kept to co-ordinate with media Reporters during the Tournament days
 - (e) A Computer & Printer with Internet facility for using the Tournament Software.
 - (f) A qualified doctor with a basic first aid kit or a Physiotherapist shall be made available all times during the tournament days.
- vi. The organizing district applying for conducting of State Multi-District, State Open, Masters, All India Ranking, International Ranking & League Events shall, at the time of application, inform the number of available courts at its disposal to the Hon Secretary MBA. Allocation of the tournament will be at the sole discretion of the Executive council of MBA as recommended by the Hon Secretary MBA. These courts should have wooden flooring / Hova Courts properly maintained to provide good playing conditions.
- vii. Hon. Secretary, MBA shall send observer to inspect the venue of the tournament which would include badminton court, Lighting system, Arrangement of Changing rooms for Gents & Ladies, Toilets, Canteen facilities, Seating Arrangements etc.
- viii. The organizing Secretary should take efforts to give proper publicity for the tournament in the local Cable TV, Local News Papers etc. Also, organizers should try to arrange sufficient electronic media coverage for the tournament.
- ix. Organizers are requested to issue a suitable circular giving all the details about the Tournament to all the Hon. Secretaries of affiliated District Associations. Same shall be published and distributed to affiliated District Associations 25-30 days prior to the start of the tournament.
- x. The Addresses of the Hon. Secretaries of Affiliated District Associations are as enclosed in Annexure 'H'.



- xi. In Multi-District, State Open, Masters, All India Ranking, International Ranking & League Events the organizing District Association will mandatorily use the brand Yonex with whom MBA has contract. However, for District level tournaments the District Association's contract will prevail over MBA's contract.
- xii. For any open tournament, if there is an involvement of players from more than one district Association but not the entire state it will be termed as a Multi District Tournament for such tournaments all the rules and guidelines of MBA will be applied.

The following are the regions defined by MBA (as per the Government GR)

- i. Konkan Region: Mumbai City, Mumbai Suburban, Thane, Palghar, Raigad, Ratnagiri, Sindhudurg.
- ii. Western Maharashtra- Sangli, Satara, Solapur, Kolhapur, Pune.
- iii. North Maharashtra Ahmednagar, Dhule, Jalgaon, Nandurbar, Nashik.
- iv. Marathwada- Aurangabad, Beed, Jalna, Osmanabad, Nanded, Latur, Parbhani, Hingoli.
- v. Vidarbha- Akola, Amravati, Buldhana, Yavatmal, Washim, Bhandara, Chandrapur, Gadchiroli, Gondia, Nagpur, Wardha.
- xiii. All tournament organizers in Maharashtra are hereby informed to take proper permission for conduction of badminton tournament/Exhibition Matches/Leagues etc. Application must be on the letterhead of the registered institution signed by the authorized person sent through the concerned District.
- xiv. For any application involving Tournament on League basis, the format of the league auction and all other details must be pre-approved by MBA before the tournament is announced.
- xv. Organizers who are organizing Masters tournaments should include disclaimer (non-labiality) clause in their circulars about the injuries and/or any other medical issue(s) a participant may have due to any reason while playing the tournament, to safeguard themselves. A fitness certificate by a registered Medical Practitioner to be submitted by the players before playing the first match. The presence of a registered Medical Practitioner is mandatory at all times during the tournament.
- xvi. Rules and Regulations regarding conditions to be followed by organizers with respect to the contract of MBA with M/s. Sunrise Sports (I) Pvt. Ltd., are attached in Annexure '1'.
- xvii. Only Yonex AS2 Shuttles should be used for the tournament.

4. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

- The tournament committee shall consist of 5 members from MBA and four to be decided by the organizers.
 Organizers shall call for a Tournament Committee meeting prior to the tournament, in consultation with the Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA.
- ii. The address of the representatives of MBA on the Tournament Committee has been annexed for your ready reference in Annexure 'C'
- iii. The members of the Tournament Committee of Maharashtra Badminton Association shall be provided with minimum facilities as under:

On request of any of the Tournament Committee members, the organizers shall make arrangement for their Lodging and Boarding. The expenses for the same shall be borne by the organizers, however any committee member wishes to stay making his / her own arrangements of lodging boarding, he/she will be reimbursed as follows by the MBA

Rs. 3,000 per day for lodging Rs. 1,500 per day for boarding.

Travelling to & fro 2nd AC fare shall be given to all committee members along with Rs. 500 as incidental expenses.



5. DRAWS:

- Draws will take place at the MBA's office in Thane or any other suitable place of Convenience in consultation with Hon. Gen. Secretary and Hon. Secretary- Maharashtra Badminton Association may Invite any 1 member of Tournament Committee, members of the Draw & Seedings Committee, Tournament Secretary, Chief Referee and Match Control.
- ii. Draws shall be made by using Tournament Planner Software, any change of venue of draw will be intimated to the organizers accordingly.
- iii. Preparations of receipt of entries, listing of entries, Draws, Fixtures, Schedule etc. will be done by Maharashtra Badminton Association at Thane office and the expenses for the same will be borne by MBA. However, if the draw is held at a location other than Thane, the expenses will be borne by theorganizers.
- iv. The draws shall be displayed by the Organizing Secretary at the Venue as and when received from MBA and also shall be displayed on MBA website by support.

6. REFEREES AND UMPIRES:

- i. MBA Court Officials Committee (COC) in which Hon. Secretary, MBA is the convener, will nominate Tournament Officials (TOs) for various tournaments.
- ii. On Conclusion of the Tournament, the organizing secretary should send "TP file" on mail to Hon. Secretary, MBA on following address immediately: vadshrikant@gmail.com with a copy to support@mbaasso.in
- iii. Organizers are requested to get in touch with the Referee for working out details of conducting the tournament with a copy to MBA.
- iv. The minimum facilities and allowances those should be provided / paid to the Technical Officials are enclosed in Annexure 'B'.

C – LODGING & BOARDING

- All other cities Rs.1800/- for lodging & Rs. 700/- for boarding and for district umpire honorarium will be Rs.700/-
- Accommodation provided to technical officials committee members officials etc should be Air Conditioned with attached toilets and shall be pre-approved by MBA observer and/or Hon. Secretary, MBA.

D – INCIDENTAL CHARGES

If the officiating hours in a day exceeds 14 hours, then additional officiating charges @ of half of
eligible DA to be paid for the day. A second set of additional officiating charges shall be paid
only if the cumulative extra hours of work in the tournament exceeds 6 hours.

These payments shall be made for tournament days plus one day extra.

Draw if attended by any referee or an umpire shall be considered as session and the same shall be paid as the honorarium including traveling expenses according to his entitlement.

GUIDELINES, RULES/REGULATIONS/INFORMATION FOR DISTRICT SECRETARIES

- BAI/MBA Registration Fees Rs. 100/- per player (to be paid once in a year, beginning on 1st July of every year) to be collected by the respective District Association.
- 50% of Registration Fees collected by District Association should be paid to Maharashtra Badminton Association along with draw copy of District Championship.

1. ENTRIES

- i. Entries for Tournaments at all Levels must be routed through MBA Website only. No District Association or organizers can use any other mode of accepting entries except MBA website.
- ii. Entries for Inter District Team Championships must be forwarded on prescribed entry form through District Secretary to Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA on vadshrikant@gmail.com on association's Letter Head. This format is enclosed herewith Annexure 'A', otherwise the entry will not be accepted.
- iii. All entries are to be approved by the Hon. Secretaries of respective district associations from their District Admin Login before the last date of entry so that the entries can be forwarded to the organizers in time. If not approved by district secretaries, after the last date of entry, a list of all entries will be displayed on MBA website with the assumption that all entries are approved by the respective District Secretaries. The District Secretary shall reject entry in case if they find any player in the list who should not be playing for whatever (disciplinary) reason and inform by sending an email to the Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA accordingly.
- iv. If by any genuine reason a player misses the deadline, then he/she will have to pay a penalty of Rs. 1,000/- per day to MBA's bank account, details of which are displayed on the MBA website. However, this extension by paying penalty fee of Rs. 1,000/- per day will only be available till last date of entry declared by BAI for all India events & penultimate day of the draw meeting of the State Tournament. District Secretary should confirm the payment of penalty and only then forward the entry for the permission of Hon. Gen. Secretary MBA, who will then forward the entry to BAI. All communication in such cases must happen via email to Hon. Gen. Secretary MBA on vadshrikant@gmail.com with a copy to support@mbasso.in.
- v. Please note that no entry will be accepted and forwarded if it is not received in the stipulated time that is mentioned in our online system on www.mbasso.in. In case of exceptions, district secretary must forward late entries/withdrawals to vadshrikant@gmail.com with a copy to support@mbasso.in after the penalty clause as mentioned in point no. iv above has been adhered to. No direct request from players for late entries/withdrawals will be entertained.

2. Tournaments:

- i. If any District Association wants to conduct either Multi-District or State Level Open Tournament, the Organizing District shall have to send their application to MBA to conduct such tournaments. Application must be on the letterhead of the District Association or the registered institution signed by the authorized person sent through the concerned District.
- ii. The tournament organizers will make an application to the concerned District Association. If found OK, the District secretary will forward the same to the Hon Secretary MBA who will check for availability of dates and approve the tournament subject to fulfilling of guidelines. From there it will be the responsibility of the District Secretary regarding the smooth conduction of the tournament as per MBA guidelines. In case if the District Association doesn't exist or is disaffiliated, then the organizer may approach the Hon Secretary MBA with their application.
- iii. No direct tournament application by any individual or Event Management companies shall be entertained unless it is sent through the respective District Association.
- iv. Tournament applications must be received by MBA office minimum One month in advance.
- v. For any application involving Tournament on League basis, the format of the league auction and all other details must be pre-approved by MBA before the tournament is announced.
- vi. MBA reserves the right to sanction appropriate number of events as per availability of courts and infrastructure. Under no circumstances the scheduled last match will be beyond 9.00pm. The players can be restricted to play in not more than 3 events in cases where it becomes difficult for referee to schedule matches.

3. PLAYER ID

i. Hon. District Secretaries should verify that the BAI player ID forms are completed in all aspects as per the BAI guidelines, along with the Affidavit, Birth Certificate, Aadhar card copies as applicable etc. & Demand Draft and send the applications to the Hon. Gen. Secretary.

 - b) Team Championships will be played separately for Men / Boys & Women / Girls Team Championships.
- 2. The Inter District Championships will be held 2 or 2.5 days prior to the Open events of the concerned State Championships.
- 3. The permissible number of members of a Team for the Inter District Championships shall be as follows:

Any player can play any two matches in different categories (Singles/Doubles) Each team will have maximum 3 officials.

- 4. The names of the Captain, Manager and Coach shall be nominated by the concerned District Association for each Team.
- The Team Championships will be held on the following basis: <u>FORMAT FOR MAHARASHTRA INTER-</u> DISTRICT TEAM

CHAMPIONSHIPS

MENS TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS-

Best of 5 matches in the following order:

- 1. 1st Men's Singles
- 2. 1st Men's Doubles
- 3. 2nd Men's Singles
- 4. 2nd Men's Doubles
- 5. 3rd Men's Singles

FOR ALL REMAINING TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS (Women, U17 & U19 Boys & Girls)

Best of 3 matches in the following order:

- 1. 1st Singles
- 2. 1st Doubles
- 3. 2nd Singles
- 6. Entries for Team Championships shall be sent along with entries for State Championships by each District on their letterhead. Entry fees for each Team event will be Rs.3,000/- (separate for Men/Boys & Women/Girls), which will be retained by the OrganizingDistrict.

- 7. The organizers of the Inter District Championships shall make arrangements of staying and food for all the participating teams, however each District Association shall bear its cost. This arrangement will be for number of days of competition plus two days extra.

 - The said eligibility will be checked, Verified and approved by the concerned District Association.
- 2. Rules of BAI and BWF will be applied throughout the tournament.
- 3. Accepting the entries will be the sole discretion of the Maharashtra Badminton Association only through each concerned District Association.
- 4. The bronze medal will be awarded for both the losing semifinalist in the team as well as Individual events.

Once the decisive match is finished the remaining matches in the Team Championships will not be played. Once the tie is decided no further matches will be played in the said Tie.

PROCEDURE FOR SENDING ENTRIES FOR ALL TOURNAMENTS IN MAHARASHTRA.

Close of entries:

- 1. Players can check under "My Entries" to confirm their tournament entry registration. In case of All India / International tournaments, if the partner is from out of state, it will be the responsibility of the player to ensure the correctness of the details of the partner (partner details will be accepted as they are entered by the registered player). A registered player can send entry for any other registered player of Maharashtra but the player can withdraw only his OWN entry.
- 2. For all State Selection, All India Ranking Tournaments and International Events all players shall send their entries online from our website www.mbasso.in. The Hon. Secretaries of respective District Associations should approve all such district entries by logging in as District Admin with the ID and password provided (if you have any queries about this approval procedure please send email to support@mbasso.in with your specific questions). Details of District Admin login, password & approval procedure has already been emailed to all the districts. If you have not received it for any reason please send email request for the same to support@mbasso.in.
- 3. Once approved by District Admins entries will be automatically be available to MBA Admin for processing and forwarding to Organizing Secretary of the Tournament.

Last Date of Entry for International tournaments is always set to 10 (Ten) clear days before the actual last date of entries mentioned by the organizers.

Last Date of Entry for" All India" tournaments may be set to 2 (Two) clear days before the actual last date of entries mentioned by the organizers.

Please note that no entry will be accepted and forwarded if it's not received in the stipulated time that is mentioned

in our online system on www.mbasso.in.

List of entries:

- 1. The organizers will get the list of entries from support after the close of entries.
- 2. The organizers are responsible for ensuring that no entry is missed out.
- 3. After the close of entries, there cannot be any changes in the original entries, except withdrawal of entries. The changes include substitution of partner or singles entry.

Listing of Entries:

- 1. Entries received online will be published on our website home page under the top left tab "TOURNAMENTS".
- 2. When the list is published, the players shall check that their entries are correctly included in the participants' list. If there is any mistake or missing of entries, they must immediately contact by emailing us at support@mbasso.in.



3. Once/If the MBA office is convinced about genuineness of the error on the part of organizers / OR MBA, they will make necessary corrections in the Listing of Entries.

Intimation of Withdrawals:

1. Any withdrawals after the date stipulated, there will be automatic fine of Rs. 500/-. No exemption under any



grounds will be allowed in payment of fine.

2. On conclusion of the tournament, the list of withdrawals / Walkovers will be forwarded to MBA office for recovery of withdrawal / entry fees from the respective District Affiliated Unit.

Draw:

- 1. The draw for all Maharashtra Tournaments will be done in Thane or at any other suitable place of convenience in consultation with Hon. Gen. Secretary through the Tournament Planner software.
- 2. On completion of the draw, the draw will be published on the MBA website 3 TO 5 days before the start of the tournament subject to the approval of the Referee of the Tournament.
- 3. The Referee will confirm technical correctness of the draw.
- 4. Once the draw is made, the TP file of the Tournament Planner will be forwarded to the Organizers for the use during the event. The draw will be displayed on Maharashtra Badminton Association's website (www.mbasso.in) under the specific Tournament name.

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES FOR TECHNICAL OFFICIALS COMMITTEE (COC)

- a. MBA Court Officials Committee (COC) in which Hon. Secretary, MBA is the convener, will nominate the Tournament Officials (TOs) for various tournaments.
- b. MBA will not nominate any TOs (including Match Control) for any tournaments if he / she is participating in the same tournament as player / active coach.
- c. Technical Officials should only officiate in the tournaments that appear on the MBA website
- d. Any Technical Official found officiating in unrecognized /Unauthorized tournaments/League matches at National/State/District Level is bound for disciplinary actions as per BAI norms. And their registrations will be frozen by MBA.
- e. The Technical Official will be allowed to officiate again only on payment of a fine of Rs. 1500/- and an assurance letter that he/she will not break the rules and standards laid down by MBA.
- f. On conclusion of all approved tournaments being conducted in Maharashtra, the Referee along with the Match Control should send "TP file" on mail to Hon. Secretary, MBA on following address immediately: vadshrikant@gmail.com with a copy to support@mbaasso.in
- g. Hon. Secretary, MBA along with COC will compile a full list of active official TOs in our state. The same will be published on the MBA website at the beginning of every calendar year. It is mandatory for every TO from the above list to inform MBA about his / her appointment for any tournament across the country and take prior permission before confirming his / her availability to BAI / Organizers of various Tournaments.
- h. The minimum facilities and allowances to be provided / paid to Technical Officials are enclosed in Annexure 'B'.
- i. All tournament organizers stroke referee should not that <u>a number 2.5 Umpires per</u> court should be nominated for all the tournaments conducted under the auspices of Maharashtra Badminton Association.

MBA shall be glad to clarify on any of the above matter and assure you to extend our full support and co-operation in smooth and successful organization of the Tournament.

i. It will be the responsibility of the organizers to collect the entry fees.

2. **GENERAL GUIDELINES**:

- i. The Players registered with Railways, Petroleum, Air India, other such organizations and Combined Universities cannot participate in these events.
- ii. No District Association or organizers can use any other mode of accepting entries except MBA website.
- iii. The district association of the organizing district & MBA shall be kept in picture and their consent should be sought in all organizational matters
- iv. During the official functions of the tournament the organizing Secretary shall follow the protocol in Consultation with Hon. Secretary MBA. It is advised that minimum 40 % of the seats on the dais shall be provided to the officials of the MBA.
- v. Organizers of the Tournament must provide the following minimum facilities at the Tournament Venue:
 - (a) Sound System to be provided at the Referees table during all the Tournament days.
 - (b) Separate dressing rooms for Gents and Ladies, along with clean toilets.
 - (c) Filtered and hygienic Drinking water.
 - (d) One person should exclusively be kept to co-ordinate with media Reporters during the Tournament days
 - (e) A Computer & Printer with Internet facility for using the Tournament Software.
 - (f) A qualified doctor with a basic first aid kit or a Physiotherapist shall be made available all times during the tournament days.



- vi. The organizing district applying for conducting of State Selection / State Championships / Inter District Championships shall, at the time of application, inform the number of available courts at its disposal to the Hon Secretary MBA. Allocation of the tournament will be at the sole discretion of the Executive council of MBA as recommended by the Hon Secretary MBA. These courts should have wooden flooring / Hova Courts properly maintained to provide good playing conditions.
- vii. Hon. Secretary, MBA shall send observer to inspect the venue of the tournament which would include badminton court, Lighting system, Arrangement of Changing rooms for Gents & Ladies, Toilets, Canteen facilities, Seating Arrangements etc.
- viii. The organizing Secretary should take efforts to give proper publicity for the tournament in the local Cable TV, Local News Papers etc. Also, organizers should try to arrange sufficient electronic media coverage for the tournament.
- ix. Organizers are requested to issue a suitable circular giving all the details about the Tournament to all the Hon. Secretaries of affiliated District Associations. Same shall be published and distributed to affiliated District Associations 25-30 days prior to the start of the tournament.
- x. The Addresses of the Hon. Secretaries of Affiliated District Associations are as enclosed in Annexure 'H'.
- xi. Organizers who are organizing Masters tournaments should include disclaimer (non-labiality) clause in their circulars about the injuries and/or any other medical issue(s) a participant may have due to any reason while playing the tournament, to safeguard themselves. A fitness certificate by a registered Medical Practitioner to be submitted by the players before playing the first match. The presence of a registered Medical Practitioner is mandatory at all times during the tournament.
- xii. Every year the Senior Inter District & State Championships will be named in the memory of Late Shri. Nandu Natekar.
- xiii. Prize money for all events should be distributed as per the break-up provided in the enclosed Annexure 'F'
- xiv. Rules and Regulations for Inter District Team Championships will be as per the enclosed Annexure 'G'
- xv. Rules and Regulations regarding conditions to be followed by organizers with respect to the contract of MBA with M/s. Sunrise Sports (I) Pvt. Ltd., are attached in Annexure 'I'.

4. ELIGIBILITY & MODE OF SENDING THE ENTRIES:

- i. Players registered only from Maharashtra through its affiliated units (District Associations) shall be permitted to participate in Sub. Junior, Junior and Senior State Selection, State Championships and Open Selection Events. However, players domiciled in Maharashtra but employed elsewhere will be allowed to take part in Inter District Championships with the consent of concerned District Association.
- ii. Incase players who are representing States/organizations other than Maharashtra (such as Air India, Railways, Petroleum, Airport Authority etc.) if they wish to represent Maharashtra and participate in the State Selection/State Championship tournaments during 2023, they should get an N.O.C from their respective states/organizations before the 1st State Selection Tournament of the season of Maharashtra and submit the same to Maharashtra Badminton Association.
- iii. Direct Entries from Players/Parents to Maharashtra Badminton Association for the above-mentioned tournaments shall not be accepted nor shall be forwarded.



viii. Entries for Inter District Team Championships must be forwarded on the prescribed entry form through District Secretary to Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA on vadshrikant@gmail.com on association's Letter Head. This format is enclosed herewith – Annexure 'A', otherwise the entry will not be accepted.

5. GUIDELINES REGARDING MBA EC MEMBERS/TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE/SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- i. The tournament committee shall consist of 5 members from MBA and four to be decided by the organizers. Organizers shall call for a Tournament Committee meeting prior to the tournament, in consultation with the Hon. Gen. Secretary, MBA.
- ii. The details of the representatives of MBA on the EC/Tournament Committee/Selection Committee have been annexed for your ready reference in Annexure 'E', 'C', 'D',
- iii. The members of the EC/Tournament Committee/Selection Committee of Maharashtra Badminton Association shall be provided with minimum facilities as under:

On request of any of the above Committee members, the organizers shall make arrangement for their Lodging and Boarding. The expenses for the same shall be borne by the organizers, however any committee member wishes to stay making his / her own arrangements of lodging boarding, he/she will be reimbursed as follows by the organizers.

Rs. 3000 per day for lodging Rs. 1500 per day for boarding.

Travelling to & fro 2nd AC fare shall be given to all committee members along with Rs. 500 as incidental expenses.

6. <u>DRAWS:</u>

- i. Draws will take place at the MBA's office in Thane and Hon. Secretary- Maharashtra Badminton Association may Invite any 1 member of Tournament Committee, members of the Draw & Seedings Committee, Tournament Secretary, Chief Referee, Match Control and Member of COC (If required)
- ii. Draws shall be made by using Tournament Planner Software, any change of venue of draw will be intimated to the organizers accordingly.
- iii. Preparations of receipt of entries, listing of entries, Draws, Fixtures, Schedule etc. will be done by Maharashtra Badminton Association at Thane office and the expenses for the same will be borne by MBA. However, if the draw is held at a location other than Thane, the expenses will be borne by theorganizers.
- iv. The draws shall be displayed by the Organizing Secretary at the Venue as and when received from MBA and also shall be displayed on MBA website by support.

- 2. The Inter District Championships will be held 2 or 2.5 days prior to the Open events of the concerned State Championships.
- 3. The permissible number of members of a Team for the Inter District Championships shall be as follows:

Best of 5 matches in the following order:

- 4. The bronze medal will be awarded for both the losing semifinalist in the team as well as Individual events.

Once the decisive match is finished the remaining matches in the Team Championships will not be played. Once the Tie is decided no further matches will be played in the said Tie.

Regarding conditions to be fulfilled by organizers.

- 1. All State Level Tournament affiliated/organized /conducted by the Association will be named as "Yonex Sunrise Maharashtra State Level / Championship Tournaments.
