Badminton Association of India has allotted to allot 43rd Yonex-Sunrise Junior National Badminton Championship-2018 to Uttar Pradesh Badminton Association to be held at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh from 16th to 22nd December 2018. The following guidelines are the guidelines.

- 1. DATES OF THE TOURNAMENT: 16th to 22nd December 2018.
- 1.1 The tournament schedule is as follows.

- 2. PRIZE MONEY:
- 2.1 Rs: 15 lakhs shall be distributed for Team & Individual Events.

3. INDIVIDUAL EVENTS:

3.1 The tournament will be organised in following age groups in Individual events.

Boys Singles - U-19	Girls Singles - U-19
Boys Doubles - U-19	Girls Doubles - U- 19
Mixed Doubles U-19	

3.2 The tournament will be organised in following age groups only having the specified eligibility criteria of date of birth. (BAI ID is mandatory).

4. TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE:

The President, BAI will nominated three members in Tournament Committee.

- 4.1 4 members shall be nominated by the Host Affiliated Unit.
- 4.2 Hon'ble President , Hon'ble General Secretary and Chairman, TC shall be the EX- officio Members of Tournament Committee.
- 4.3 The Secretary (Events), BAI shall be a Convenor.
- 4.4 These members shall be given facilities as specified in Annexure B & C of the Competition Regulations for attending the Nationals and meetings thereof,

5. MODE OF COMPETITION:

- 5.1 All the matches in the main draw shall be played best of three games of 21 points on a rally point system.
- 5.2 The Organisers shall adhere to the date lines as specified as above of this circular.

6. ENTRIES:

6.1 The Entries shall be received by BAI as per the existing system with a copy to org.Secretary. The entries are to be received through Affiliated Units. (Direct entries from the Players are not valid).

- 6.3 No entry shall be accepted unless, the player has been allotted a Player ID and has submitted the age proof as per the BAI Competition regulations.
- 6.4 Once the entries are duly verified, the Main & Qualifying entries shall be placed in BAI Website.
- 6.5 It shall be the responsibility of the Affiliated Unit and the players to ensure that all the entries send by them appear in the M & Q List. After the Last Date for withdrawals without penalty, no complaints shall be entered for miss out of any entry. The BAI is not responsible for any omissions or correction of names.
- 6.6 Each Member Association shall be entitled a quota of entries as mentioned below. The Member Associations have to claim the quota by specifying the entries and additional entries while sending their entries.

BAI & BWF eligible ranked players should send their entries through the respective Members Associations before the last date of entries.

In case of absentees further ranked players are not eligible in their quota.

In pair events both players should have BAI ranking below $\,$ 16 only in U-19. Partnership with points will not be considered.

For example No.1 ranked player wants to play with a partner having BAI rank above eight (6) is not eligible. Both partners should have ranking below 16 only.

6.8.3 The Host.Association is eligible to participate in this year Team Championships.

7.1 MIXED TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS:

7.2 NOMINATION OF TEAMS FOR A TIE (TEAM EVENT)

1. No player shall play in more than two events.





- 2. Each competing Member Association is responsible for determining the criteria and method of selecting players for nomination, and for nominating players, to represent its Association.
- 3. Each manager in the managers' meeting shall submit 3 Boys singles and 3 Girls Singles, 3 Combination of Boys & Girls Doubles and 3 Combination of Mixed Doubles in order of team championships. The same ranking order shall be valid for all ties throughout the competition, subject to the maximum players of not more than 5 in each category. For example one player can be nominated in singles / doubles / Mixed Doubles but he or she can play only in two events. For combination purpose a player may be nominated in 3 events but he/she can participate in two events only. Referee is authorized to take the final decision with the consultation of respective manager. In doubles, each team shall play its one pair according to the previously submitted ranking order.
- 4. No substitution of player/pair shall be permitted under any circumstances once the team nominated for the competition.
- 5. Each tie shall be decided by the best of 5 matches as follows.

One Boys Singles

One Girls Singles

One Boys Doubles

One Girls Doubles

One Mixed Doubles.

- 6. Each manager shall handover the players nomination form to the Referee as per the order of merit during managers meeting. (With pair combination). Play in each tie shall be stopped when the tie is decided.
- 7. No substitution shall be permitted by the Referee after the draw is completed.
- 8. Play in each tie shall be stopped whenever the tie is decided with 3 matches. It may be 3-0, 3-1 or 3-2 matches.
- 9. A player withdrawn in singles in the following ties is permitted to participate in pair event in the same tie.
- 10. Any change of sequence in order of play in the following tie shall be informed to the Referee in writing before two hours of the commencement of the tie. (1^{st} or 2^{nd}). Otherwise, the Referee will continue with order of Merit submitted by the Manager during managers meeting before commencement of Tournament.
- 11. The referee shall inform such changes to the opponent team immediately
- 12. Players withdrawn in one tie is permitted to play in the next tie.
- 13. Any player participating in two matches is entitled to a minimum interval of 20 minutes between them.





8. **HOSPITALITY:**

8.1 The organizers shall be responsible to provide free hospitality to the participating players, officials from each member Association as follows.

Junior Nationals	Free hospitality to 8+2=10 members including manage Coach and BAI /BWF Ranked players and Zon Individual eligible players.	
Extra Players/officials shall pay	Rs:1000/- per day per head The organizers provide maximum 3 days coupons on payment.	
Inter Zonal Mixed Team Winners	Eligible for free hospitality to 2 members extra.	

Zonal Individual events- Semi Finalists in singles and finalists in pair events are not eligible for free hospitality. Each Member Association is eligible for 12 members free hospitality including regular quota of and Zonal Individual eligible players.

- 8.2 The Host Affiliated Unit shall provide free lodging and boarding facilities for the tournament days plus one day before and lodging up to 12noon of the next day.
- 8.3 Every Member Association team taking part in the Nationals shall be responsible for all expenses incurred for their travel and other incidental expenses. Local Transport shall be provided by the organizers as per the timings pasted on the notice board.

9. DRAW

9.1 The Main Draw shall be held during Managers Meeting one day before commencement of the Individual events .

10. WITHDRAWALS.

- 10.1 If there are any withdrawals notified by the Member Association after the close of entries, the same shall be intimated to BAI immediately with a copy to the organizers before the closing date of with drawls. However change of partner or replacement of entry shall be permitted during Managers Meeting.
- Any player failing to participate in any BAI approved tournaments after draw is made, he/she is liable to pay Rs:1000/- (one thousand) fine before participating in next tournament. No exemption under any grounds (including medical) will be allowed in payment of fine. No player is permitted to participate in the next tournament without paying fine. Referee shall submit the withdrawal list to BAI within 48 hours after completion of the tournament to the Secretary(E), BAI.

PROTEST

The fees for lodging protest of any kind shall be Rs. 1000/-. This fee shall be retained by the organizers of the event. Any protest shall be addressed to the Org. Secretary in writing within one hour after completion of the match. Produce to receive the results of Medical test will take minimum six months.

12. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS:

12.1 The Court Officials shall be nominate by BAI.

12.2 In addition to the above, the Host Organisers shall nominate one Local Deputy Referee, one Umpires' Control, one Announcer and One Media relation officer to assist the Referee in conduct of the matches along with local umpires and line judges.

12.3 All the Technical Officials will be provided with the facilities as specified in Annexure "B"

12.4 CERTIFICATES:

Participation and Merit Certificates shall be presented to all the players. Participation certificates shall be signed by Org.Secretary, President of Host. Assn, General Secretary & Secretary (E),BAI

Merit Certificates shall be signed by the Hon'ble President, General Secretary & Secretary (E) of BAI.

13. **EQUIPMENT SPONSOR:**

- 13.1 As per contract of BAI with Yonex, organisers shall be provided Yonex Shuttlecocks. Additional shuttlecocks shall be purchased by the organisers..
- 13.2 Sponsorship guidelines will send to separately and follow strictly the regulations.

14. OTHER POINTS:

14.1 The organizers are requested to issue a suitable circular giving all the details about the Tournament to all the Hon. Secretaries of Affiliated Units of BAI. Details of Venue, hotels with their phone numbers & Tariff, Distance from Railway station, Important contact phone numbers and other facilities provided to the participants.

16. RAIL CONCESSION

- 16.1 Rail Concession forms will be sent to the concerned affiliated units of BAI on advance request to Secretary (E), BAI.
- 16.2 The affiliated units may send the list of participants with age and sex for issue of Rail concession forms. (If required)

In case of International events (except India Open Super Series) organised in India, referees, Match Control and International umpires from India will be provided with the following facilities:

Travelling	Economical flight to & fro (above 300 k.m and booking within 2 days of receipt of nomination) or 2 nd AC Class both ways rail fare. + Rs:300/- both ways from house to railway Station & back. (Tatkal and Rajadhani not permitted).
Travelling allowance	Rs. 500/- per 24 hours journey or part thereof.
Lodging	Free lodging and breakfast for tournament days plus one day extra.
Officiating and food allowance	Rs. 2000 for the tournament days plus one day extra.

Entries Liaison: The Host Association shall pay an amount of Rs:7500/- for each ranking tournaments and Rs:15,000/- for each Nationals to the BAI nominee (working with Secretary (E),BAI towards maintenance of Entries, M&Q List, withdrawals, Draws etc.

ANNEXURE C
