**MODE OF COMPETITION:**

All the matches in the main draw shall be played best of three games of 21 points on a rally point system. The qualifying round matches in best of Three (3) games of 15 points each with extension of 21 points.

- Each member Association of BAI is eligible to send two singles, one double and one Mixed Double in each event in 35+,40+,45+,50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+.
- **A player is eligible to participate in not more than 3 events (1Singles, 1 Double & 1 Mixed Double)**

The entry fees for qualifying participants shall be as follows.

Singles events of all categories	Rs. 750/- per player
Doubles events of all categories	Rs. 1500/- per pair

The qualifying draw shall be made at BAI Office. Using the Tournament Planner software.


### EQUIPMENT SPONSOR:

## REVISED ANNEXURE B

### FACILITIES TO BE PROVIDED TO THE BALTECHNICAL OFFICIALS by the Host Organization

Officiating allowance	Rs.2000/- per day plus one day extra
Miscellaneous	Rs:1500/- including taxi fare

#### **Honorary Deputy Referee , Match Control and International Umpires.**

Travelling	2 <sup>nd</sup> AC Class both ways rail fare. ( Tatkal and Rajadhani not permitted).
Officiating allowance	Rs. 1750/- per day plus one day extra.

#### **Grade I Umpires:**

Travelling	3 <sup>rd</sup> AC Class both ways rail fare. ( Tatkal and Rajadhani not permitted).
Officiating allowance	Rs. 1500/- per day plus one day extra.

#### **Grade II**

Travelling	3 <sup>rd</sup> AC Class both ways rail fare. ( Tatkal and Rajadhani not permitted).
Officiating allowance	Rs. 1200/- per day plus one day extra

#### **State Umpires**

Travelling	2 <sup>nd</sup> Sleeper class both ways rail fare . ( Tatkal not permitted).
Officiating allowance	Rs. 700/- per day plus one day extra

#### **Local Umpires:**

Conveyance allowance in lieu of local travelling, lodging.	Minimum Rs.200/- per day for tournament days + Free boarding . (No accommodation )
Officiating allowance	As per applicable to appropriate category / grade.

**In case of International events ( except India Open Super Series ) organised in India, referees , Match Control and International umpires from India will be provided with the following facilities:**

Travelling	Economical flight to & fro ( above 300 k.m and booking within 2 days of receipt of nomination ) or 2 <sup>nd</sup> AC Class both ways rail fare. + Rs:300/- both ways from house to railway Station & back. ( Tatkal and Rajadhani not permitted).
Travelling allowance	Rs. 500/- per 24 hours journey or part thereof.



Lodging	Free lodging and breakfast for tournament days plus one day extra.
Officiating and food allowance	Rs. 2000 for the tournament days plus one day extra.

**Entries Liaison:** The Host Association shall pay an amount of Rs:10000/- for each ranking tournaments and Rs:15,000/- for each Nationals to the BAI nominee ( working with Secretary (E),BAI towards maintenance of Entries, M&Q List, withdrawals, Draws etc.

#### ANNEXURE C

#### FACILITIES TO BE PROVIDED TO BAI REPRESENTATIVES by the Host Organization
