If there are any withdrawals after the close of entries, it shall be intimated to BAI immediately by the Affiliated Units/ player before the closing date of withdrawal.

Any player failing to participate in any BAI approved tournaments after draw is made, is liable to pay Rs:1500/- for each event (one thousand five hundred) fine to BAI beforeparticipating in next tournament. No exemption under any grounds (including medical) will be allowed in payment of fine. No player is permitted to Participatein the next tournament without paying fine.

Referee shall submit the withdrawal list to BAI within 24 hoursafter Completion of the tournament to the Secretary (E), BAI. On receipt of the list Member Associations concerned shall collect the lineamount and forward to the Associations concerned.
