RULES, REGULATION & GENERAL INFORMATION

ABOUT THE TOURNAMENT

- 1) Tournament is open to players to Maharashtra State Players.
- 2) The Tournament will commence from 24th May, Wednesday to Sunday 28th May 2023 at Indoor Badminton Hall, Eklavya Sports Complex, Somaiya Vidyavihar Campus, Vidyavihar (E), Mumbai- 400077
- 3) Play is scheduled to commence at 9.00 am, subject to load shedding and other changes with prior intimation.
- 4) This Tournament will be conducted as per the rules and regulations for tournaments as laid down by BWF and BAI. The decision of the tournament committee will be final and binding on all players.

HOW TO SEND THE ENTRIES

- 1) Individual entries must be sent by online – www.mbasso.in . Only online entries would be accepted. Entry fees will be collected at the Venue on the day of Tournament
- 2) Last date of entries is 16th May, 2023 till 5 pm

ABOUT THE DRAWS

- 1) List of entries received shall be displayed on Maharashtra Badminton Association website at www.mbasso.in
- 2) Draws and fixtures using Tournaments Software and as per the revised regulations of B.W.F will be put up on the notice board as well as displayed on Maharashtra Badminton Association website on 22nd May, 2023 and one day before at the Tournament Venue

HOW THE TOURNAMENT IS GOING TO BE CONDUCTED

- 1) Line Judges may not be appointed for the matches till Quarterfinals. Players will have to work as line judges whenever called by the Tournament Officials
- 2) Each Competitor must report to the Hon. Referee on his arrival at the venue of the tournament, Players failing to report on the court when called by the Hon. Referee, will be liable to be scratched
- 3) Clothing during play must be as per the new regulations issued by B.A.I. Advertising on the clothing is allowed as per BWF rules
- 4) Yonex brand shuttles, approved by MBA will be provided
- 5) Next day matches fixtures will be displayed online
- 6) Matches will be played in Best of 3 games of 15 points each, without extension at 14 all up to pre- quarter finals, From quarter finals onwards matches will be played in Best of 3 games of 21 points each with extension at 20 all.
